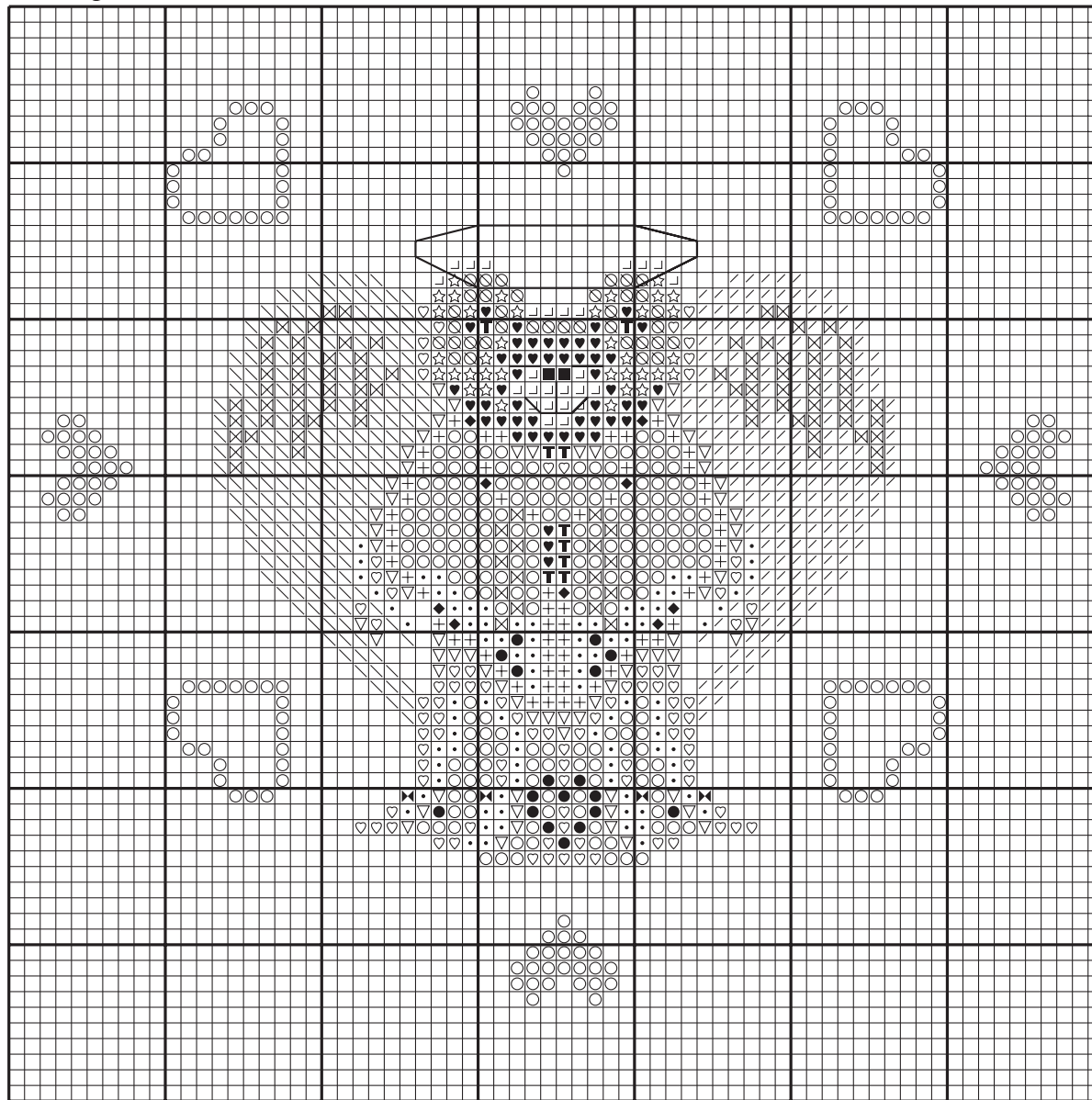


Angel Teddy

Nose, eyes and mouth: Straight stitches using a single strand of DMC 310.
Halo: Straight stitches using a single strand of Kreinik 321J (Gold) Japan thread.

Please note: All stitches are cross-stitches unless otherwise noted. All stitching uses a single strand of thread unless otherwise noted. The Gold tent stitches in the Teddy's wings go in the same direction as their neighbouring White tent stitches.

Please have fun and make this little Teddy your own... stitch the hearts which surround him or the metallic threads in his wings and on his gown in soft, pastel colours; fill the open hearts with pastel or metallic threads; stitch the hearts in Kreinik's glow-in-the-dark threads; give him pastel wings or stitch them in Rainbow Gallery's soft, fuzzy Wisper thread... I'm sure you can think of many other interesting possibilities.

STITCHED ON 18-COUNT TILE BLUE AIDA BY ZWEIGART (#3793-510) THIS PIECE (with a stitch count of 66 stitches wide by 59 stitches high) HAS A DESIGN AREA OF APPROXIMATELY 3 3/4" by 3 1/2"... on 16-count fabric it would be approx. 4 1/4" x 3 3/4".
